



Sports Coaching at Caulfield Grammar School - Frequently Asked Questions

What age/ability level are the teams?

Students generally compete in year level based teams, not age group-based teams, and the School enters different teams at each year level, based on student ability.

What is the time commitment for training?

Specific hours vary depending on the team & training venue, but the basic time commitments are:

Year 10-12 students

Tuesdays & Thursdays from 3.00pm to 5.00pm (some teams until 5.30pm)

Year 7-9 students

Mondays from 1.30pm to 4.00pm & Wednesdays from 3.00pm to 5.00pm (some teams until 5.30pm)

Year 5 & 6 Students

Mondays from 3.00pm to 5.00pm & Wednesdays from 12.00pm to 4.00pm

What is the Saturday commitment?

All coaches are required to coach and supervise teams during Saturday competition. Sessions are for a minimum of two hours and where the team travels by bus to the competition venue, coaches are required to travel with the team.

What are the salary range & payment arrangements?

Sports coaches are employed on a general staff hourly rate contract with the hourly rate based on a successful candidate's experience and qualification. All coaches are paid for a minimum of 2 hours per session and Saturday competition hours are paid at a rate of 1.5 times the hourly rate. Coaches are paid fortnightly, with any additional requirement due to bus travel or additional coaching sessions for training and competition being included.

What happens once I have applied?

The School regularly screens all applications prior to the closing date for applications. Candidates who are deemed to have the right level of experience and qualifications may be phone screened prior to the closing date. If you are phone screened, this will then be reviewed in relation to the number of vacancies available and you will then be notified via email whether your application will proceed to interview.

If the School doesn't have an appropriate coaching position to consider you for based your level of qualifications and experience, you will be notified via email.

When will I know whether my application has been successful?

The School will update all applicants via email generally within 10 working days of the closing date.
